COURSE DURATION

Half day course (4 hours), depending on location, including practical activities.

CERTIFICATE

COURSE OUTLINE

This course covers the following:

- Resuscitation of an infant or child
- Choking
- Control of bleeding
- Poisoning and acute illness
- Management of shock
- Wounds
- Burns
- Bites, stings

There are no entry requirements or prerequisites to undertake this training.
